The Helping Hand Food Pantry (HHFP) is a cooperative ministry of the Hillsdale Christian Churches, united in the name of Jesus Christ, and supported by other volunteers in the community, who join their hearts, hands, time, energy and resources to provide food for those in need.

The Helping Hand Food Pantry evolved from a need recognized in 1992 by a young Boy Scout, who took the initiative to organize a food drive for his Eagle Project.
